The Governor of Manipur is pleased to declare that the days specified in the Annexure-I will be observed as "GENERAL HOLIDAYS" for the "Calendar Year 2026" under the Government of Manipur.

2. In addition to the holidays mentioned in **Annexure-I**, all Government employees will be authorized to avail 2 (two) "RESTRICTED HOLIDAYS" out of those mentioned in the **Annexure-II**.

3. Festival at Sl. No. 14 of the Annexure-I, may be replaced in respect of the Hill Districts and the Manipur Bhawans, Kolkata, Delhi and Guwahati by Holidays of local importance after taking prior approval of the Government by 31st January, 2026. The above festival may, however, be included as Restricted Holidays in the Hill Districts and the Manipur Bhawans.

4. Further, in exercise of the powers conferred by the explanation of section 25 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 (Act XXVI of 1881), the Governor of Manipur is pleased to declare the days specified in the **ANNEXURE-III** as "PUBLIC HOLIDAYS" for the year, 2026 in Manipur.
